BENEFITS OF TAKING CCU DUAL CREDIT COURSES

- Higher GPA in college
- Affordable college credit that transfers nationwide
- Prepares students for rigors of college courses

- Shortens the time required to complete an undergraduate degree, allowing for the option of pursuing an additional major

REGISTRATION STEPS

- 1. Talk to your high school about available CCU Academy dual credit courses.
- 2. Contact colleges or universities of interest in order to determine how CCU Academy dual credit courses will transfer.
- 3. Visit ccu.edu/academy/dual-credit/registration/ to register.
- 4. Pay the course fee at the time of registration. (If payment is made to your high school, payment will not be required for your CCU Academy course registration).
- 5. You will receive a CCU student ID and confirmation email when your registration is successful.

August 15 - November 15

Fall Registration: Fall and Yearlong Courses

August 15 - December 1

Drop and Refund: Fall Registrations

January 15 - April 15

Spring Registration: Yearlong and Spring Courses

January 15 - May 1

Drop and Refund: Spring Registrations

May 15 - July 15

Summer Registration: Summer Courses

May 15 - August 1

Drop and Refund: Summer Registrations
